

PART 2 – PRELIMINARY

2. NAME

The name of the organisation shall be Drummoyne Community Centre Incorporated.

3. DEFINITIONS

(1) In this Constitution:

“**DCC**” means the Drummoyne Community Centre Incorporated.

“**Committee**” means the DCC Management Committee comprising the persons referred to in clause 15 of this Constitution.

“**Committee Member**” means an office bearer or member of the Committee who is a Member of DCC and either duly elected at an annual general meeting of Members or appointed in accordance with clause 19 or clause 22.

“**Life Member**” is a Member whose life membership status has been ratified under clause 5A and who has not ceased to be a Life Member under clause 6.

“**Group Member**” means an organisation or group which is a Member of DCC. A Group Member is entitled to one vote per group.

“**Secretary**” means:

- (a) the person holding office under this Constitution as Secretary of DCC; or
- (b) if no such person holds that office – the Public Officer of DCC.

“**Council Representatives**” means two persons nominated by City of Canada Bay Council pursuant to clause 15(2) of this Constitution.

“**Special General Meeting**” means a general meeting of DCC other than an annual general meeting.

“**the Act**” means the Associations Incorporation Act 2009 (NSW).

“**the Regulation**” means the Associations Incorporation Regulation 2016 (NSW).

(2) In this Constitution:

- (a) a reference to a function includes a reference to a power, authority and duty; and
- (b) a reference to the exercise of a function includes, if the function is a duty, a reference to the performance of the duty.

(3) The provisions of the Interpretation Act 1987 (NSW) apply to and in respect of this Constitution in the same manner as those provisions would so apply if this Constitution were an instrument made under the Act.
